Training In Lieu of Experience (TILE)

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This course is designed to provide students with an introduction to road laws and legislation affecting heavy vehicle operators, and is a process which enables a person to progress from a Class C (Car) licence to a Heavy Combination (HC) learners permit.



ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students must have held their Class C (Car) licence for at least two years (Including P's) to be eligible. Must be at least 19 years of age and have a current and valid SA Car licence.

Applicants must be physically fit – should the applicant have any identified medical issues that may prevent them from driving this class of licence, an approval to gain a heavy vehicle licence from the Licencing Regulator is also required.

All applicants will undertake a short assessment to determine whether this is the best course for their needs, including language, literacy and numeracy skills. Where learning needs are identified, LITA Training may offer you additional support or refer you to a more suitable course.
